It is the solely grant in aid teacher education institution working for the betterment of females under the affiliation of Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa. The institution is working towards their education, empowerment and all round development which can be gauged from the organization of number of activities to enhance their physical, mental, cultural and social aspects. The college endeavours to achieve the best in different ways for the perfection of future female teachers for sustainable developments.

The vision of the college is empowering women educationally, socially, morally and economically endowed with values and wisdom which leads to their holistic development. The mission of the college includes imparting value based and quality education for producing quality teachers for school education. It also includes the objective of developing sensitivity towards emerging issues like environment, global peace, road safety, women health, gender equality etc. The college works to develop awareness among teacher trainees about the modern trends in education like inclusive and eco-friendly education. To meet the objectives of vision and mission of the institution, IQAC plans for the curricular as well as co-curricular activities to be held during the session in the

form of tentative academic calendar. The entire faculty is responsible to conduct all the activities planned by IQAC during the session.

In the session 2022-23, the talent of the female students were recognized by organizing Talent Hunt Competitions. Singing, Solo Dancing, Declamation, Poem Recitation, On the Spot Painting, Instrument Playing, Mimicry, Mono Acting, Videography, Photography, PPT Competitions were organized to find all type of Talent embedded among the female students. Independence Day, Azadi ka amrit mahotsav, Republic day, Shaheedi Diwas, National Youth were celebrated to imbibe National values among the future teachers. Plantation Drive was carried out to celebrate the Van Mahotsav under HAR GHAR TIRANGA. Poster Making and Slogan Writing Competitions were organized on topic “Environment Conservation”. Preparation of Improvised Apparatus Competition was organized on Science Day to imbibe the knowledge regarding reuse of the waste material and use it as improvised apparatus. National Seminar approved by the DGHE, Haryana on topic “Understanding the environment for sustainable development” was organized by the Eco club for enhancement of the awareness of the students, staff and community towards this critical issue. A team of Science Students

visited the Vermi Compost Farm at Village Bharokha, District Sirsa and the Principal accompanied and acknowledged the students regarding the process of Vermi compost farming. Best out of Waste Creativity Competition was organized to celebrate World Environment Day. The plastic waste is collected periodically and removed from the campus by the authorities of municipality. A Poster Making Competition was also organized by the Eco Club on topic “Plastic Free Campaign” to celebrate the World Environment Day. A pledge was also taken by the students and staff of the college to not to use the single use plastic. Students are encouraged to create minimum waste in the campus by bringing food in steel tiffin boxes, water in steel bottles etc. E-wastes are stored in secured place with a view to reuse some of its working parts. The equipment which cannot be reused, disposed off safely after official procedures.

To sensitize the women towards key aspects of women’s health, a number of activities were organized during the session. Personal health guidance was given by the Principal herself time to time. All the faculty members made efforts to aware the girls regarding their personal health during routine lectures also. Counseling of girls was carried out by the Guidance Counseling and Placement Cell and Women Cell regarding their problems of cramps and pains during periods. An Extension Lecture was organized by the Women Cell with Resource Person Dr. Parvinder Singh Sandhu of Oncology Dept., Cancer Institute Bathinda on topic “Myths, Causes and Prevention of Breast Cancer.” Extension Lecture on “Cyber Crime” was organized by the Legal Literacy Cell with Mrs. Seema Sodhi, SHO, Mahila Police Thana as the resource person. Women Cell organized creative competitions of Mehndi Decoration, Diya, Candle, Thali Decocration and Rangoli designing to develop aesthetic as well as cultural aspects of the female students. A symposium on “School Health Awareness” was also organized by the Women Cell. 39th Sports Meet was organized in the college to imbibe the sense of Sportsmanship with healthy competitions and its role in maintaining good physical health.
