Bhagwan Shri Krishan College of Education (for women) is solely grant in aid teacher education institution working for the betterment of females under the affiliation of Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa. The vision of the college is empowering women educationally, socially, morally and economically endowed with values and wisdom which leads to their holistic development. The mission of the college includes imparting value based and quality education for producing quality teachers for school education. It also includes the objective of developing sensitivity towards emerging issues like environment, global peace, road safety, women health specially the menstrual health, gender equality etc. The college works to develop awareness among teacher trainees about the modern trends in education like inclusive and eco-friendly education. To meet the objectives of vision and mission of the institution, IQAC plans for the curricular as well as co-curricular activities to be held during the session in the form of academic calendar. The entire faculty is responsible to conduct all the activities planned by IQAC during the session 2023-24.

In the session 2023-24, the talent of the female students were recognized by organizing Talent Hunt Competitions. Singing, Solo Dancing, Declamation, Poem Recitation, On the Spot Painting, Instrument Playing, Mimicry, Mono Acting, Videography, Photography, PPT Competitions were organized to find

all type of Talent embedded among the female students. Independence Day, Republic day, Shaheedi Diwas, National Youth Day were celebrated to imbibe National values among the future teachers. To create the sensitivity towards environment, resolution to not waste the electricity and water was taken as pledge on the Orientation Day. Vermi Composting Pit, Water Harvesting Tank and Biodegradable Compost pit are prepared and used properly. Plantation Drive, Plastic Free Campaign Drive was also carried time to time during the session 2023-24. The plastic waste is collected periodically and removed from the campus by the authorities of municipality. A pledge was also taken by the students and staff of the college to not to use the single use plastic. Poster Making and Slogan Writing Competitions were organized on topic "Environment Conservation". Preparation of Improvised Apparatus, Best out of Waste Creativity Competitions were organized on Science Day and World Environment Day to imbibe the knowledge regarding reuse of the waste material. E-wastes are stored in secured place with a view to reuse some of its working parts.

To sensitize the women towards key aspects of women's health, a number of activities were organized during the session. Personal health guidance was given by the Principal herself time to time. All the faculty members made efforts to aware the girls regarding their personal health during routine lectures also. Counseling of girls was carried out by the Guidance, Counseling and Placement Cell and Women Cell regarding their personal problems. Girls were

motivated by expert doctors time to time to inquire about their personal health during or after the extension lectures during the session. World AIDS Day was celebrated and An Awareness Documentary was displayed to regarding myths, causes and prevention of HIV AIDS. A number of activities of Poster making, Pledge Against Drugs, Group Discussion as well as Documentary Display were organized by the Anti Drugs Awareness Club during the session 2023-24. A documentary was displayed by the Women Cell on Menstrual Hygiene. An Extension Lecture was organized by the Women Cell with Resource Person Dr. Parvinder Singh Sandhu of Oncology Dept., Cancer Institute Bathinda on topic "Myths, Causes and Prevention of Breast Cancer." Knowledgeable Documentary was displayed on World Mental Health day. 40th Sports Meet was organized in the college to imbibe the sense of Sportsmanship with healthy competitions and its role in maintaining good physical health. The students also participated in the Mini Marathon for motto "Drugs Ends Dream." Sh. Kaushal Kishore Ji, Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi delivered an online lecture on topic "A Step to Aware" for developing awareness towards ill effects of drugs abuse. An awareness rally on Stop drugs among youth inaugurated by Mrs. Seema Sodhi, SHO, Mahila Police Thana was also organized to reach the community awareness. A magic show on "Social Evils" was displayed to the students. A rally on the World AIDS Day was organized for the awareness of the community on the deadly disease.

Women Cell organized creative competitions of Mehndi Decoration, Diya, Candle, Thali Decocration and Rangoli designing to develop aesthetic as well as cultural aspects of the female students. Cooking Without Fire competition was also organized on International Women Day.

The institution endeavours to imbibe duties related to good citizenship by organizing number of activities during every session. Road safety week was celebrated in the month of January by organizing Pledge to follow the traffic rules, Slogan Writing and Essay Writing competitions on 'Road safety, Life Safety' issues. Extension lecture on "Nash Ek Samajik Barai and Cyber Crime" was organized by the Guidance, Counselling and Placement Cell.
